In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

David R. Morse

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N. Y. in the District of Buffalo Creek and is one of the firm of Morse & Penne and that said firm owns the one half part undivided of the Schooner "Cornelia" of Buffalo and that Thomas S. Parker resides at the same place and owns the remaining one half part undivided, and that they are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner "Cornelia" of Buffalo whereof T. S. Parker is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N. Y. in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port July 2d 1857 number 109 now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 13 1/2 feet 2 inches her breadth 25 feet 9 inches her depth 10 feet 10 1/2 inches and that she measures Three hundred fifty nine (359) tons to 3 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern and a plain head.

And the said David R. Morse having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
