In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Metropolis of Buffalo whereof James Monney is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrollment dated at this Port May 13, 1858 number "54" now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts having certified that her length is 126 ⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches and that her breadth is 28 ³⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches and that her depth is 11 ⁴/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures Three hundred fifty nine tons 34 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner had a Square stern and Figure head.

And the said John L. Sewett and Augustus C. Taylor having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
