PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850. and an Act to authorize the Enrollment, Registry and Licensure of certain Steam Boats of vessels owned by the Buffalo and Lake Huron Steam Navigation Company approved March 1st 1859.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Brantford* Canada West and is Secretary of the Buffalo and Lake Huron Rail Road Company, a Corporation organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York and that said Company is the true

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Steam Boat 'Troy'* whereof *A Whittaker*

is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Maumee* State of *Ohio* in the year 1845, as appears by her former Enrollment dated at this Port 7th June 1854 number 127 the Certificate of which has been lost as appears by the affidavit of *A H Squier* on file in this Office and having changed Owners

And said Enrollment  
the said Steam Boat or Vessel has *Ten* deck and *One* mast and that  
her length is *182* feet *6* inches  
her breadth *27* feet *6* inches  
her depth *11* feet *4 1/2* inches  
and that she measures *five hundred forty six (546)* tons *47* ninety-fifths  
that she is a *Steam Boat* has *no* Gallies stern/  
and a *Scroll* head.

And the said *Wm Maclean* Secretary &c  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
