PORT OF BUFFALO.**

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

D. R. Morse

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. as is one of the firm of Morse and Penine doing business in the said City of Buffalo - and that said firm is composed of himself, said D. R. Morse, and Henry Penine - and that said firm own one half part of the *Sug Populw Uncle Ben*, ~~underwritten~~, and Morris Hazard owns the remaining one half part underwriter of said *Sug* and they are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Sug Populw* (called the *Uncle Ben*) of Buffalo whereof *And. Moller* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this port 14th September 1857. numbered 144. Surrendered December 7th 1858. Having changed owners

And said Certificate the said *Sug Populw* Vessel has *One* deck and *no* mast and that her length is *95* feet *5* inches her breadth *20* feet *5* inches her depth *9* feet *—* inches and that she measures *One hundred fifty five* tons *— 31 —* ninety-fifths that she is a *Steam Sug* has a *round* stern and *no* figure head.

And the said *David R. Morse* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sug* has been duly Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo, N. Y.**
