In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek New York, and is owner of 3/4 part undivided and Peter Relf resides at Detroit Mich. and owns the remaining 1/4 part undivided & that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller "Sun" of Buffalo whereof the said Imson is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port June 2<sup>d</sup> 1855 Number 84. Now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Certificate the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One mast having certified that her length is 191 feet 11 inches her breadth 28 feet 6 inches her depth 72 feet 0 inches and that she measures 32 hundred twenty nine (629) tons 3/5 and that she is a Propeller and no figure has a square stern head.

And the said Jacob Imson agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
