In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek N. Y. and is Secretary of The American Transportation Company, a Corporation organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York located at Buffalo and that said Company is the true

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller "Niagara" of Buffalo whereof Lewis Gray is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City State of Ohio in the year 1849, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port September 7 1855. At 206 now surrendered by reason of said Company having changed its President.

And said Certificate having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One mast and that her length is 173 feet 4 inches her breadth 24 feet 4 inches her depth 11 feet 1 inch and that she measures Four hundred & fifty (450) tons - 59 - ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a stern head.

And the said James C. Evans and Secretary having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
