PORT OF BUFFALO.**

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

James C. Evans

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is Secretary of the American Transportation Company, a Corporation organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, located at Buffalo and that said Company is the true

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Buffalo of Buffalo whereof A. S. Colby is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1851, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 27th 1855 numbered 20 now surrendered said Company having changed President.

And said Enrollment the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 202 feet 2 inches her breadth 29 feet 1 1/2 inches her depth 12 feet 2 inches and that she measures Six hundred Eighty nine tons 21 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said James C. Evans having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
