In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on Coast Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam" passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sheffield, Ohio State of Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Cleveland, May 14th 1859 numbered 33, now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts and that having certified that

her length is 77 feet inches
her breadth 18 feet 6 inches
her depth 4 feet inches

and that she measures Sixty one tons 32 ninety-fifths that she is a Sloop Schooner and has a Square stern head.

And the said F. N. Myers agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
