In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

James C. Evans

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, that he is Secretary of The American Transportation Company, a corporation organized and doing business under the laws of the State of New York, located at Buffalo, and that said Company is the true

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Ohio of Buffalo whereof Alfred McKelison is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Mack River State of Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 15th 1855 numbered 146 now surrendered by reason of a change of the President of said Corporation.

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is 159 feet 4 1/2 inches her breadth 25 feet 9 inches her depth 11 feet 3 1/4 inches and that she measures four hundred forty one tons 66 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a round stern head.

And the said James C. Evans and having agreed to the description and advertisement, above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
