Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller "Mount Vernon" +  
of Buffalo Tonawanda whereof Alvin Dodge is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Akron Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 31, 1854 No 18 now surrendered by reason of a change of Officers of said Company

And said Certificate having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and two mast and that

her length is 178 feet inches  
her breadth 29 feet 4 inches  
her depth 11 feet 8 inches

and that she measures Five hundred seventy seven tons  $\frac{77}{100}$  ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a Square stern head.

And the said Birds A Root and no figure having agreed to the description and admeasurement, above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
