In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on land Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1858, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Frank Perin
having taken & subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek, and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Invincible* of Buffalo whereof *F. Perin* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 14th 1857 numbered "78" now surrendered having changed owner and having also received an additional Mast

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and three masts and that her length is 136 feet inches her breadth 30 feet inches her depth 11 feet inches and that she measures Four hundred thirty seven tons 80 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern and no figure head.

And the said *Frank Perin* having agreed to the description and measurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
