In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Tug Propeller 'Gov King'* of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1858, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrollment dated at Cleveland September 19, 1856 no '80' - now surrendered having changed Owners and Districts.

And said Certificate having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 55 feet — inches her breadth 14 feet 6 inches her depth 6 feet 2 inches and that she measures Forty Three tons - 55 - ninety-fifths that she is a Tug Propeller has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said John Ely has agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Tug Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
