In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and Board Passengers propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July 1832, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

Augustus C. Taylor
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and owns one undivided half part of the Schooner Fashion, and that John Jewett, resides at said Buffalo and owns one undivided half part of said Schooner, and both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the Fashion of Buffalo whereof Janus M. Butler is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Detroit April 26th 1858. numbered "44" Now surrendered, by reason of a change of owners & district and having been rebuilt at Buffalo in the year 1859.

And B. Logan Special Surveyor, appointed to re-measure said Schooner, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that

her length is 118 feet 2 inches
her breadth 23 feet 11 inches
her depth 7 feet 6 inches

and that she measured Two hundred & twenty three tons - 35 - ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a square stern head. and a figure head.

And the said Augustus C. Taylor agreed to the description and admeasurement as specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
