In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and is President of the International Paub. a corporation organized under and doing business under and by virtue of the State of New York. Located at Buffalo; and that said Company is the true

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Schooner Gardinell
of Buffalo whereof J. M. Butler

is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan State of Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 24th 1858 numbered '36' surrendered November 14th 1858 having changed owners.

And the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 121 feet 6 inches her breadth 24 feet 10 inches her depth 11 feet 1 inch and that she measures Three hundred and eight tons 8 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a figure head.
