In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on small Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending that same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and is President of The International Bank, and that said Bank is doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, and is the true

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Schooner "Fox" of Buffalo whereof *A. H. Dowman* is the present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1852, as appears by her former Enrollment dated at this Port June 11th 1858 numbered 73, now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment the said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *Two* masts and that her length is *148* feet *9* inches her breadth *27* feet *3* inches her depth *10* feet *8* inches and that she measures *Two hundred five* tons *Nine* ninety-fifths that she is a *Square* stern head

And the said *Merwin S. Hawley* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
