District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

John S. Hayes

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns one half part undivided, and that James Roby resides at Buffalo and owns the remaining one half part undivided of the Brig Cleander, and that they are

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the said Brig "Cleander" of Buffalo whereof J. D. Harrison is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ashtabula State of Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by her former Enrollment dated at this Port May 21st 1859 numbered "46" (now surrendered having changed owners*)

And said Enrollment the said Brig or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 118 feet 10 inches her breadth 26 feet 1/2 inches her depth 9 feet 8 inches and that she measures Two hundred & sixty two tons 38 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square stern and a scroll head

And the said John S. Hayes agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
