In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and is Secretary of The American Transportation Company - a Corporation organized under and doing business by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, located at Buffalo, and that said Company is the true

~~Citizen of the United States~~ and sole owner of the Propeller New England of Buffalo whereof J.R. Andrews is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by her former Enrollment dated at this Port May 4, 1855, number 47, now surrendered by reason of a change of said Company's President.

And said Certificate the said Propeller or vessel has One deck and One mast and that her length is 184 feet 5 inches her breadth 20 feet 6 inches her depth 11 feet 0 inches and that she measures Three hundred & fifty one tons - 67 - ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and no figure

And the said James L. Evans agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
