



# ENROLLMENT.



## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July, 29th, 1850.

William Williams

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns one third part undivided of the Propeller New England and that Henry Martin, & Andrew J. Rich reside at the same place and own, each one third part undivided of said Propeller, & that they are

Citizens of the United States and sole owners of the Propeller New England of Buffalo whereof William Williams is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port 25<sup>th</sup> October 1859, now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Certificate the said Propeller or vessel has One deck and One mast having certified that her length is 134 feet 5 inches and that her breadth is 20 feet 6 inches and that she measures Three hundred & fifty one tons No 7 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a square stern and no figure head

And the said William Williams agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
