



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveiances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

William Williams

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and owns one third undivided of the Propeller Potomac, and that Andrew J. Rich and Henry Martin reside at said Buffalo and own the remaining two thirds parts undivided of said propeller and that they are all

Citizens of the United States and sole owners of the said Propeller Potomac of Buffalo whereof William Williams is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1855, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port 25th October 1855 numbered 228 now Surrendered having changed owners.

And said Certificate the said Propeller or vessel has One deck and Two masts and that her length is 209 ¹⁴/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 39 ⁴/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 12 ⁴/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures Eight hundred & eighteen tons 110 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a plain steam head

And the said William Williams agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y. having
