



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

William Williams

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns one undivided third part of the Propeller Chicago and that Andrew J. Rich and Henry Martin reside at said Buffalo and own each one third part, undivided of said Propeller, and that they are all.

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Propeller Chicago whereof William Williams is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1855, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port October 5th 1859, numbered '122' now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment the said Propeller or vessel has One deck and One mast and that her length is 197 feet 10 inches her breadth 31 feet 3 inches her depth 12 feet 10 1/4 inches and that she measures Seven hundred fifty eight tons - #3 - ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a Round stern head

And the said William Williams having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
