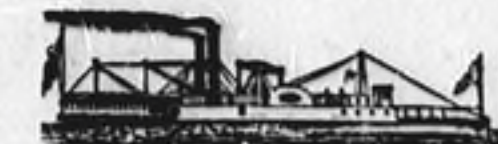




# ENROLLMENT.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending that same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and is a

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Schooner "Golden Harvest" whereof J. S. Comstock is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1860, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrollment dated at the Port of Cleveland April 19. 1860 number 29 now surrendered, having changed Owners and Districts.

And said Certificate the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 131 feet 8 inches her breadth 28 feet 4 inches her depth 11 feet inches and that she measures Three hundred seventy six (376) tons - 1/4 - ninety-fifths that she is a Square stern head and no figure

And the said George W. Tiff having agreed to the description and advertisement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
