In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838; and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. & owns jointly with Selim Sears, under the firm name of Sears & Clark, the whole of the Schooner "Hurricane"; and they are

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the Schooner Hurricane of Buffalo whereof Joseph Mercer is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the last Enrollment dated at this Port August 30th 1859 numbered '88' now surrendered having changed owners

And say of Enrollment the said Schooner or vessel has her length is 125 feet 3 inches her breadth 26 feet 3 inches her depth 11 feet inches and that she measures three hundred thirty one tons and has a square stern and a scroll head having certified that the said Schooner has a square stern and that she is a Schooner and a scroll head

And the said Seth Clark agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
