In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and is a

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Propeller T.W. Bradbury of Buffalo whereof Frank Perue is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1855, as appears by her Certificate of last Enrollment dated at this Port September 21 1857 number 158 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Propeller or vessel has One deck and One mast having certified that her length is 178 <sup>5/8</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches her breadth 27 <sup>4/8</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches her depth 11 <sup>5/8</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches and that she measures 545 tons 94 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a Square stern and Plain head

And the said Frank Perue agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
