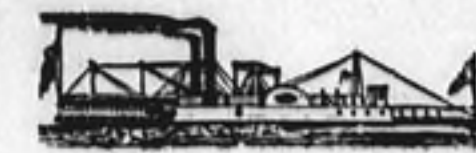

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo* and is a

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Schooner *Carrie Woodford* of *Buffalo* whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Dunkirk* State of *New York* in the year *1859*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at the Port of *Dunkirk* May 12th 1859, no. 5 now demoulded having changed owners & districts,

And said Certificate the said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *95* feet *6* inches her breadth *19* feet *5* inches her depth *7* feet *5* inches and that she measures *One Hundred & twenty seven* tons *11* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern head and no figure

And the said *John Booth* having agreed to the description and advertisement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo*, N. Y.
