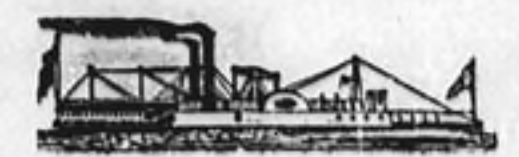




ENROLLMENT.

District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending that same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is a

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Schooner *H. A. Farnham* whereof *O. Lyon* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Broome* State of *New York* in the year *1856*, as appears by a temporary Certificate of Enrollment dated at the Port of *Chicago* April 27th 1860 No. *27* now surrendered by reason of her return to her home district

And said Certificate the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *116* feet *8* inches her breadth *26* feet *4* inches her depth *10* feet *10* inches and that she measures *Three hundred & two (302)* tons *50* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a *Square* stern head and *No figure*

And the said *John H. Lockwood* having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
