Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New London State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of J. Ingers. Shipwright, her builder on file in this office

And William J. Post Special Surveyor appointed ^{said vessel} to examine ^{to measure} having certified that the said Canal Barge or vessel has One deck and no mast and that her length is 95 feet inches her breadth 16 feet 8 inches her depth 7 feet inches and that she measures One hundred and forty 104 tons 36 ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Barge has a Barge and no figure stern head

And the said Falkner having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Barge has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
