District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Alexander S. Anderson

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and is a

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Tug Propeller "Rapid" of Buffalo whereof J. C. Robinson is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by her Certificate of last Enrollment dated at this Port June 10th 1857 numbered 100 now deemed having changed owners, under and by virtue of a Decree of the District Court of the United States issued the 25 day of June 1858

And the said Certificate the said Tug Propeller or vessel has her length 81 feet 4 inches her breadth 6 feet 6 inches her depth 8 feet and that she measures Sixty nine tons and that she is a Tug Propeller having certified that she has One deck and no mast and that she has a round and plain stern head

And the said A. S. Anderson agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Tug Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
