### District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending that same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and owns  $\frac{5}{14}$  parts undivided of the Schooner Storm King, *John Duff & Joseph Duff* own  $\frac{2}{14}$  parts undivided, *George Duff* owns  $\frac{1}{14}$  parts undivided, *Charles H. Gray* owns one fourteenth part undivided - *Suey Duff* one fourteenth part and *May Duff* one twenty eighth  $\frac{1}{28}$  parts undivided

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the said Schooner Storm King of Buffalo whereof *Joseph D. Whitney* is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of last Enrollment dated at this port April 21st 1860. numbered 20 now surrendered having changed owners

And by said Certificate the said Schooner or vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *120* feet *3* inches her breadth *25* feet *3* inches her depth *11* feet *3* inches and that she measures *Three hundred & seventy five* / *375* tons *37* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a *Square* stern head and a figure *—*

And the said *G. W. Duff* having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
