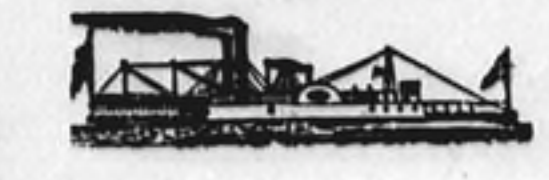

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Albany in the County of Albany, New York, and that Samuel Morgan resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and that they are

Citizens of the United States ^{each of one half part undivided,} and sole owners of the *Sug Daniel Brown* of Buffalo whereof *J. Colburn* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1860, as appears by the certificate of *William Crosthwait*, the builder on file in this office

And *B. Logan* Surveyor appointed to measure said Vessel having certified that the said *Sug Popille* or vessel has *One* deck and *no* mast and that her length is *57* feet *—* inches her breadth *13* feet *2* inches her depth *6* feet *—* inches and that she measures *Thirty seven* tons *10* ninety-fifths that she is a *Span-tack* and *plain* stern head

And the said *S. A. Chase* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sug Popille* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
