And said certificate the said Propeller or vessel has One deck and One mast and that her length is 173 feet 4 inches her breadth 24 feet 4 inches her depth 11 feet 1 inch and that she measures from the keel fifty tons 59 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a square stern head
