In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and that William Williams and Andrew J. Rich reside at the same place and each own one undivided third part of the Propeller Frost Queen, and that they are

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the Propeller Frost Queen of Buffalo whereof Martin is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City State of Ohio in the year 1852 as appears by the certificate of last Enrollment dated at this Port May 15th 1855 no. 67 now demurred having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Propeller vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is 162 feet inches her breadth 25 feet 8 inches her depth 11 feet 9 1/2 inches and that she measures 467 1/2 tons that she is a Propeller has a square stern and a plain head

And the said Henry Martin having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
