And P. Logan appointed to measure said Canal Boat having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 95 feet inches her breadth 17 feet inches her depth 7 feet 3 inches and that she measures One hundred & nine tons 91 ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a Square stern and no figure head

And the said Ym Petrie having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
