State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of  
C. A. Vanslyke Shipwright her builder on file in this Office

And B. J. Swan Surveyor appointed to measure said boat having certified that  
the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast and that  
her length is 93 feet 8 inches  
her breadth 18 feet 8 inches  
her depth 8 feet 9 inches  
and that she measures One hundred & twenty six tons 47 ninety fifths  
that she is a Canal Boat has a Square stern  
and no figure head

And the said E. J. Evans having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
