In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending that same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Canal Boat Elizabeth  
of Macedon whereof E. J. Evans

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo  
State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of  
C. A. Manslyke Shipwright her builder on file in this Office

And E. J. Evans Surveyor appointed to measure said Boat having certified that  
the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and No mast and that  
her length is 94 feet 6 inches  
her breadth 16 feet 9 inches  
her depth 9 feet inches  
and that she measures One hundred thirty four tons 8 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Canal Boat has a Square stern  
and No figure head

And the said Odorin J. Evans having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
