In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken and subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and that *Sir Allen* resides at the same place and that they are

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Schooner *Genius* of Buffalo whereof said Thomas S. Parker is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of her former Enrollment dated the Port of Oswego April 16, 1860 number 7 - now amended having changed owners

And said Certificate One having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has deck and two mast 8 and that her length is 116 feet 6 inches her breadth 24 feet inches her depth 10 feet inches and that she measures Two hundred & sixty six tons 50 ninety-fifths shearn head that she is a Schooner and a screw head

And the said Thomas S. Parker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
