In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 29th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

John S. Ganson

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is President of the New York and Erie Bank, a Corporation organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York located at Buffalo and that said Bank owns the 317/405 parts undivided, that William G. Fargo is Secretary of the American Express Company a corporation organized by virtue of the laws of the State of New York and owns the remaining 88/405 parts undivided, and that said Bank and Express Company are Citizens of the United States and sole owners of the Steam Gallie of Buffalo whereof J. M. Ansell is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 5 to 1856 numbered 66 now Surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Steamer or vessel has One deck and no mast and that her length is 225 feet 7 inches her breadth 30 feet 4 inches her depth 12 feet 6 inches and that she measures 823 tons that she is a Steamer

And the said John S. Ganson has no Gallies 37 ninety-fifths stern head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steamer has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
