

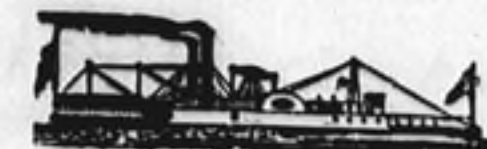

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Lewis P. Roy

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and owns, individually one half part of the Schooner Dunbury and that William F. Hardwell, George Webster and Lewis P. Roy under the firm name of Hardwell, Webster & Co doing business in the City of Buffalo own the remaining one half part undivided of said Schooner and that they are

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the Schooner Dunbury
of Buffalo whereof Chad W. Gray is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo
State of New York in the year 1859, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port September 30th 1859
Number "118" now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate
the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and Two masts and that
her length is 123 feet 4 inches
her breadth 25 feet 6 inches
her depth 7 feet 10 inches
and that she measures Two hundred twenty seven tons 24 ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a Square stern
and a Scroll figure head

And the said Lewis P. Roy
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
