In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers and Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by her Temporary Register dated at the Port of Boston & Charleston on the 3rd day of August 1860. Numbered 245 now numbered having Thayer W. owners

And said Temporary Register the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and two mast & having certified that her length is 136 feet 9 inches her breadth 26 feet 7 inches her depth 11 feet 6 inches and that she measures three hundred eighty one (381) tons 29 - ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a figure head

And the said Augustus C. Taylor having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
