In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Lyman Mungier

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Rochester N.Y. and is a

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Steamer *Minnesota* of Buffalo whereof he is Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Maumee State of Ohio in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port November 1st 1860. No. 152. Now surrendered having changed address

And said Certificate the said Steamer or vessel has One deck and One mast and that her length is 235 feet — inches her breadth 30 feet 10 inches her depth 10 feet 8 inches and that she measures Seven hundred & fifty nine tons 45 ninety-fifths that she is a Steamer has a Square stern and no figure

And the said Lyman Mungier agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steamer has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
