In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and owns three fourth parts undivided, and that William R. Campbell of Buffalo, owns the remaining one fourth part undivided. that they are

Citizens of the United States and sole owners of the Brig *Albion* of Buffalo whereof W. R. Campbell is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ashtabula State of Ohio in the year 1848, as appears by the certificate of her former Enrollment dated at this Port May 21st 1839 to her now surrendered by reason of a change of owners

And said Certificate the said Brig or vessel has One deck and Five masts and that her length is 118 feet - 6 - inches her breadth 26 feet - 1/2 - inches her depth 9 feet - 8 - inches and that she measures Two hundred Sixty two (262) tons 38 ninety fifths that she is a Brig has a square stern head and a screw

And the said James Roby having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
