In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Schooner Colorado
of Buffalo whereof *J. P. Watson* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland
State of Ohio in the year 1861, as appears by the certificate of Peck
Master also shipwright his builder on file in this office

And *J. P. Watson* duly sworn and appointed to measure said vessel having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One deck and three masts and that
her length is 147 ⁹⁰/₁₀₀ feet — inches
her breadth 30 ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ feet — inches
her depth 12 ¹⁰/₁₀₀ feet — inches
and that she measures Five hundred and three tons — *144* — ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner and has a Square stern head
and a foremast
