In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Lewis B. Proctor

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and that he owns one third part of the Canal Boat Galena of Buffalo undivided and that John Rose of Buffalo my own the remaining two thirds part undivided of said Canal Boat and that they are

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the Canal Boat Galena of Buffalo whereof *L. B. Proctor* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of John Nelderhouse shipwright her builder on file in this office

And *P. Logan* Surveyor appointed to examine said boat having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no masts and that her length is 91 feet 3 inches her breadth 17 feet 3 inches her depth 7 feet 10 inches and that she measures One hundred and fourteen tons sixty eight/68 ninety fifths and that she is a Canal Boat has a round stern head and plain figure

And the said *Lewis B. Proctor* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
