In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

John J. Lockwood

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo NY and that he is the owner of the Schooner City of Buffalo and that Alfred Kime who resides at Windham Connecticut is the owner of one fourth part of said Schooner (undivided) and that Stephen H. Howell of the City of Buffalo NY is the owner of the remaining one half part (undivided) of said Schooner and that they are

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the Schooner City of Buffalo of Buffalo whereof Abel Brown is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1861, as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port the 11th day of April 1861

And by Enrollment the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 14 3/4 feet inches her breadth 30 7/10 feet inches her depth 11 4/10 feet inches and that she measures four hundred and fifty five tons ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has a square stern head

And the said John J. Lockwood having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
