In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Nichols of Buffalo and that W.E. Sauton of Erie Penn is the owner of the remaining one half part undivided of said Barque and that they

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the Barque W.P. Nichols of Buffalo whereof Carlton Graves is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Madison State of Ohio in the year 1861, as appears by her Register dated at the Port of Cleveland May 8 1861 and a number

Now amended for the purpose of being enrolled having changed details And said Register having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 146 ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 30 ²/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 11 ⁷⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures *From hundred* *square* six tons 9 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern head and a figure head

And the said James Butler having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
