In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at New Haven in County of Oswego State of New York and that he is the owner of one fourth part including any that John Law who resides at Albany State of New York owns the remaining three fourth part of the Schooner Cunningham and that they

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the said Schooner Cunningham of Buffalo whereof Charles Hamilton is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City State of Ohio in the year 1803, as appears by the Certificate of her Enrollment dated at this Port May 16 1854 number 86 and now undergoing raising changes owners

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has on deck and two masts and that her length is 120 feet 9 inches her breadth 24 feet 9 inches her depth 10 feet inches and that she measures two hundred seventy five tons 115 ninety fifth she is a Schooner has a square head and no figure

And the said Charles Hamilton having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
