In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

John H. Lockwood

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and that he is the owner of one fourth part undivided of the Schooner City of Milwaukee and that that Alfred Winn who resides at Waukegan Connecticut and Stephen W. Howell who resides at Buffalo N.Y. are the owners of the remaining three fourths part undivided of said Schooner and that they are all

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the Schooner City of Milwaukee of Buffalo whereof said vessel is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of his Enrollment dated at the Port of New York 11 1861 number 24 now remaining having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 140 ²⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 29 ³/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 11 ³⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures four hundred thirty six tons 53 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern head and figure head

And the said John H. Lockwood having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
