In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo NY* and that he is a

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the *Schooner J. P. Saurer* whereof *Paul M. Donato* is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* State of *New York* in the year *1861*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated *Oct 13 1860* number *146* now remaining said vessel having been rebuilt in the year *1861*

And *N. Walcutt* Surveyor appointed to measure said Schooner having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *three* masts and that her length is *127* feet *0* inches her breadth *24* feet *0* inches her depth *7* feet *6* inches and that she measures *Two hundred eight* tons *40* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a *square* stern head and *no figure* head

And the said *William Sears* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
