In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is the owner of one fourth part undivided of the Brig Propeller Jennie Bell and that Mary Ann Rice who resides at Swanton Island County of Erie State of New York is the owner of the remaining three fourths part undivided of said Brig Propeller and that thus an

Citizen of the United States and sole owners of the Brig Propeller Jennie Bell of Buffalo whereof Jacob Klepser is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1858, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 7 1859 and numbered 28 now running having changed name

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Brig Propeller or vessel has one deck and no mast 6 and that her length is 58 feet inches her breadth 14 feet 10 inches her depth 6 feet 1 inches and that she measures twenty six tons 62 ninety-fifths that she is a screw and no figure

And the said J. J. Klepser having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
