In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo NY and that he is the owner of the undivided joint half part of the Sloop of James of Buffalo and that Judson B Bennett and Horace B Ostrum who reside at Evansville NY are each the owners of one fourth part undivided of said Sloop and they all are

Citizens of the United States and sole owners of the Sloop of James of Buffalo whereof Horace B Ostrum is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Acorn State of New York in the year 1861, as appears by the certificate of Joseph A Cameron Shipwright her builder on file as this office

And Sanford Hallist Surveyor appointed to measure the Sloop having certified that the said Sloop or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 96 feet 6 inches her breadth 23 feet inches her depth 6 feet 8 inches and that she measures one hundred thirty three tons fifty three ninety fifths that she is a Sloop Schooner has a square stern head and no figure

And the said Seymour Bennett having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
