In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 29th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo NY and that he is the owner of the one half part undivided of the Eng Propeller J.W. Rabody and that Sarah H. Muzzey of Buffalo is the owner of the remaining one half part undivided of said Eng and that they both are

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Eng Propeller J.W. Rabody of Buffalo whereof L.C. Muzzey is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he

Citizen of the United States and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1861, as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at the Port dated the 8th day of May 1861 and number 39 now summing having changed owners

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Eng Propeller or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 57 feet 3 inches her breadth 13 feet inches her depth 5 feet 7 inches and that she measures thirty three tons 16 ninety-fifths that she is a Eng Propeller has a round stern and rafter stem head

And the said L.C. Muzzey having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Eng Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
